

Privacy Policy of Hangar 646



We invite you to read the following document on privacy protection on our website <https://www.hangar646.pl> (hereinafter referred to as the "website") and the method of data processing.

Personal data are processed in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation - hereinafter referred to as "GDPR").

Every data subject has the right to access their

personal data, rectify it, delete it or limit its processing, including the right to object to its processing, as well as the right to transfer data and lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority (in Poland, this is the President of the Personal Data Protection Office).

Principles of processing personal data based on Cookies consent

If you consent to the processing of cookies and similar technologies, the scope of data and their purpose, including the processing period and recipients of the data, vary depending on the specific cookies and similar technologies you consent to. Cookies are divided into the following categories:

Analytical cookies

- a) Monitor website traffic and optimize user experience
- b) Assess which marketing channel has better results

We use Google Analytics (<https://www.google.com/analytics/terms/pl.html>). This allows us to examine information such as preferences and settings of the computer, mobile phone or other device from which you connect to the website. This helps to display pages faster and better. Additionally, we analyze how you found the website, what elements are clicked most often, what is searched for on the website and in the Google browser before entering.

Advertising cookies

You can consent to analytical cookies or personalisation cookies or advertising cookies or all of them. Similarly, you can withdraw your consent to each of them individually or all of them. You can change/withdraw your consent via the website by clicking on the link at the bottom of the page. The legal basis for processing is consent pursuant to Article 6, paragraph 1, point a of the GDPR. The recipients of the data are companies cooperating with us and their authorized employees in the scope of handling technical, legal or advertising processes.

Cookies are processed until you change your settings (withdraw your consent or delete them from your browser). Remember that withdrawing your consent does not mean that we do not keep the history of how the data was processed. We do this for the purposes of establishing, pursuing or defending legal claims. Such data is deleted after the period for potential settlement of claims in accordance with the law.

If you agree to remember your choice at the stage of adding participants to the ticket, we process your e-mail address and the data you entered. This data is processed for the purpose of more convenient completion of fields during your next visit. The data from the selection is remembered for a period of 1 year from the date of its entry or reuse (selection from the list and saving). The legal basis for processing is consent pursuant to Article 6, paragraph 1, point a GDPR. The recipients of the data are companies cooperating with us and their authorized employees in the scope of handling technical, legal or advertising processes.

Consent is given voluntarily and you can change it at any time by sending information from your email to biuro@hangar646.pl. Remember that withdrawing consent does not mean that we do not keep the history of how the data was processed. We do this for the purposes of establishing, pursuing or defending legal claims. Such data is deleted after the period for potential settlement of claims in accordance with the law

Principles of processing personal data based on the performance of a contract or taking action at the request of the data subject, before concluding a contract.

By making a reservation, you accept the regulations and agree to the provision of the service and the implementation of the contract on the principles specified therein. We process the data provided by you that is necessary for the correct and safe implementation of the service. We never ask you to provide your card details and any financial information. All payments are made in accordance with the regulations using the payment gateway and the operator providing payment services. The legal basis for processing is art. 6 sec. 1 item b of the GDPR. Your data is processed for the duration of the contract and after this period for the period necessary to pursue legal claims provided for by law (we process data for the purpose of establishing, pursuing or defending legal claims). The recipients of the data are companies cooperating with us and their authorized employees in the scope of handling technical, legal or accounting processes.

All data provided by you before the commencement of the implementation of the contract, i.e. making a reservation, is processed solely for the purpose of completing the purchasing process. This data is deleted after closing the website.



Principles of processing personal data in connection with handling inquiries, complaints or grievances.

By sending us an e-mail or otherwise contacting us in connection with submitting an inquiry, complaint or claim regarding the services we provide, you provide us with the scope of data that we process in order to handle this inquiry/complaint or claim. If in connection with handling this process we have more data, we can analyze it for the purposes of resolving the complaint or claim or answering a question. The legal basis for processing is art. 6 sec. 1 item f of the GDPR. Your data is processed for the duration of the response process and after this period for the period of time necessary to pursue legal claims provided for by law (we process data for the purposes of determining, pursuing or defending legal claims). The recipients of the data are companies cooperating with us and their authorized employees in the scope of handling technical, legal or accounting processes.

Principles of personal data processing in connection with the legitimate interest of the Administrator, i.e. monitoring.

Monitoring is carried out in order to ensure safety. The area covered by monitoring is the area of the facility (communication routes, reception, bar and other marked areas) and the area in front of the entrance to the building. Recordings are stored for a period of 1 month from the date of production of the last monitoring material. In the event that the recording is secured for the purposes of the proceedings, the data storage period is extended until the claims expire. The legal basis for processing is Article 6 paragraph 1 point f of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on

the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC.

Principles of personal data processing in connection with the legitimate interest of the Administrator, i.e. sending surveys (examination of the quality of services provided).

The legal basis for processing is art. 6 sec. 1 point f of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC. The data was collected directly from the person to whom it relates. The legitimate interest is that the administrator receives feedback on whether the service was provided correctly, in accordance with the terms and conditions, and how the customer assesses the use of the service. Participation in the survey is voluntary. The survey is conducted electronically.

In addition to the rights listed in the privacy policy, everyone has the right to object by clicking on the link in the email. The recipients of the data are authorized employees and associates, including companies cooperating in the field of handling technical, legal or customer service processes. The data is not transferred outside the EEA. Each time you use the services, an email is sent after the end of the service with an invitation to participate in the study. Your result and the email address associated with it are processed for a period of 1 year, and after this period it is deleted unless there are circumstances for pursuing or defending legal claims provided for by law (the period is extended for the duration of the proceedings).
